






Manastash Creek







Instream

Initial Scope

- Consolidate Diversions
- Pipe Deliveries
 - KRD 13.8 lateral
 - Gravity pressure
- **Provide Passage**
- Convert Winter StW to Wells

Roadblocks

- POD Changes
 - 'Re-adjudication,' pot. loss of water
- Piped Deliveries
 - ❖ Take any water "savings"
 - What about return flows?
- No Assurances
 - Irrigators felt at risk; not 'whole'


Roadblocks

- Facility Ownership
 - ❖ \$1M+ structure
 - Insurance & Operation Costs
- WA Water Trust
 - Winter StW benefits minimal
 - Cost, complexity

Outcome

- Full Consolidation Abandoned
- Individual Fish Screens Pursued
 - No changes in points of diversion
- Delays
 - 2004 not very productive
- Frustration
 - Willing partners felt at risk
 - Commitment to funders left unmet

Progress



Revised Scope

- Partial Consolidation
 - Manastash, Reed, Hatfield, Anderson
- Individual Fish Screens
 - Consolidated, Keach+Jensen, Barnes
- Pipelines
 - Upper Manastash Ditch
 - Consolidated to Reed near Cove Rd




- Designs: Screens & passage


