Valuation Methods

- Market Analysis (Comparable Sales)
- Conservation Projects (e.g., IEGP Costs)

Water Supply Reliability

- July 1 reduction to 50% ALL RIGHTS
- Post-July 1 complete curtailment of ALL Class 3 & Junior water rights
- Post-July 1 continuing prorationing of Class
 2 rights
- Poor water reliability translates into lower marketability and value of Manastash Creek water rights

Considerations

- Limited Amount of Purchase Money
- Implementation of Consolidated Diversion
 Depends Upon Putting 6 cfs Instream
- We Will First Purchase Water Offered at Less than Maximum Value per Class (to ensure your sale, offer it at less than max)
- Public Funding Must Be Spent Wisely

- Terms and Criteria
- Bid Letter
- Pre-Auction Informational Meeting

Results

- 187 letters out
- 7 bids returned
- 5 water right holders provided 3cfs
